

What is Kumon?

Kumon is an international learning program that offers Math and English curricula. An initial assessment determines the student's low and comfortable starting point. Through long-term daily practice and a well-established routine, students do progress to advanced study.

Who comes to our centre?

Any child is welcome in our Kumon centre, because the study plan is customized for every student and is frequently reviewed and adjusted as needed. Therefore, students we have include:

- Students struggling in school
- Students wanting to do more
- Students who are bored at school
- Students looking to improve time management
- Students looking to acquire study skills

Transferring Student?

An appointment is required to complete the transfer. You can book it online or with reception. The student must be present to redo the last achievement test, unless the results are made available by the instructor. A transfer form is also required. The family then fills out payment and scheduling forms and off we go. There is no cost or obligation for the family.

New Student?

An initial appointment is required to start. You can book it online or with reception. The student must be present to do the assessment. At the same time, the framework and expectations of the program will be discussed. There is no cost or obligation for the family.

The Commitment

The fundamental philosophy of Kumon is daily practice in small doses. That is how permanent acquisition of skills, techniques and knowledge takes place. Because of that, a year of continuous uninterrupted study is the minimum. Most of our families have been with the centre for many years.

What you pay for...

- Your spot as per the chosen time slot, regardless of absences or missed classes
- A well-trained, certified and licenced instructor
- An individualized study plan
- Evaluation and observation at centre
- Guidance as needed
- Development of good study habits and independent learning skills
- Evaluations at the end of every level
- Supplemental materials
- Progress meetings as parents deem necessary, up to four times a year

The Cost

Compared to other supplemental education programs, Kumon is among the most affordable. Monthly tuition is \$130 per month per subject. There is a one-time enrolment fee of \$80, unless you discontinue and return. The one thing to keep in mind is that Kumon works in calendar months, not rolling or partial months.
